

## **ADB TV Box Guide**

Connect the Set Top Box to your TV using one of the options below.



## **Good - Coaxial Cable**

Connect one end of the coaxial cable to RF Out on the STB and the other to the RF IN on your TV (consult your TV manual). Your TV will need to be tuned to channel 3 in order to view programming. This is a Non HD connection.



**Note**: Arrow to Arrow. Arrow on the cable connector that must match up to the Arrow on the box. Make sure flat spot lines up. **Important**: If not matched up correctly the pins bend/break easily and the box it will not work.

**Better - Analog AV cable** 



Composite Non-HD Video/Audio

yellow=**video**white=**left audio**black (black plugs into red audio on tv) =**right audio** 



Component HD Video/Audio

red, blue, green=video
white (white to white on TV) =left audio
black (black plugs into red audio on tv) =right audio

Connect the specialized cable end to the AV output of the STB and the other ends to your TV using either composite in or component in on your TV. This will require that your TV to be set to a video input of Video or COMP in order to view programming (consult your TV manual).



**Best - HDMI Cable** 

Digital Video and audio HD delivery. Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI port on the STB and the other to your TV. This will require that your TV to be set to a video input of HDMI in order to view programming (consult your TV manual).
